# Administration and Justice

### **Administration Reform**


- Essentially completed the first stage of departmental restructuring:
- Conducted a public consultation on the preliminary plan for the establishment of a municipal organisation that is not an organ of political power:
- Formulated a restructuring plan for consultative bodies;
- Completed the consultation process on the Civil Servant Ranking System (first stage), and commenced the related research work System (first stage);
- services appraisal mechanism, introduce third-party evaluation; and
- Implemented the new unified recruitment system, and improved the promotion and training system.



### e-Governance

- Promoted electronic public services, and launched 15 kinds of electronic public services during the year;
- Completed optimisation of the workflow for approving and issuing administra-tive permits and licences for 18 items related to retail, food and beverage, and restaurant businesses; and
- Constructed an online registration and public notary system.









# **People's Livelihoods**

### **Healthcare and Sports**

- Completed the Territory-wide Health Survey Pilot Scheme and the Colorectal Cancer Screening Pilot Programme:
- Established the Geriatric Ward and Alzheimer's Disease Treatment Centre; Established the Children's Comprehensive Assessment Centre;
- Passed the Legal System on the Handling of Medical Incidents;
- Completed the reconstruction of Coloane Health Station and the nsion of Seac Pai Van Temporary Hea**l**th Station
- Completed construction of Coloane Public Health Clinical
- Completed the third Macao Residents Physical Fitness Assessment Report.

## **Social Security**

# Gaming Industry
