Contribution deadline: (contributions of long-term employees, arbitrary system contributions, employment fee for non-resident workers) contributions and employment fee for the preceding quarter are paid quarterly in January, April, July and October; (contributions of casual workers) contributions are paid in the month that immediately follows the employee's work month.

3. Municipal Affairs Bureau's Public Services Centres and Sub-Stations, and designated banks only accept FSS's payments that are made on time.

4. With the Employer Registration Number/beneficiary's Macao SAR Resident ID number, you may use various electronic payments of GovPay and VISA / Master Card to pay.

5. Applies only to Bank of China, Industrial and Commercial Bank of China (Macau) Limited, Banco Comercial de Macau S.A., Tai Fung Bank Limited, Banco Nacional Ultramarino S.A., China Construction Bank, China Guangfa Bank, Well Link Bank and OCBC Bank (Macau) Limited.
